Category 1B: Academic Fees – Subject POST Program Fees (<i>Fees charged as a single rate</i>) Commerce Specialist – Year 2 or Higher Concurrent Teacher Education Program (CTEP)		
The University of Toronto Mississauga Program Fee assesses a single fee for Fall-Winter full-time studies. Within the envelope of a full-time course load (3.0-6.0 credits), students under the Program Fee may add and cancel courses without generating either further charges or refunds for individual enrolment transactions. If you are appropriately assessed a Program Fee, a refund is generated only by completely withdrawing from studies by the deadlines, as explained below.		
If you cancel your registration for the session, Program fees are reversed in accordance with this schedule, using the registration cancellation date recorded on ROSI. Cancellation of registration only occurs when all courses are cancelled. If any courses with a final standing remain on the record for the academic session– a final mark, CR/NCR, P/FL– a student will not be eligible to cancel the registration for that session, and thus will not be eligible to have the program fee charges reduced.
